Project update

Following the announcement for the South West Renewable Energy Zone (SW REZ) Access Rights Tender in April 2025, Squadron Energy is continuing to develop Conargo Wind Farm. Alternative project layout and transmission connection options are currently being explored.

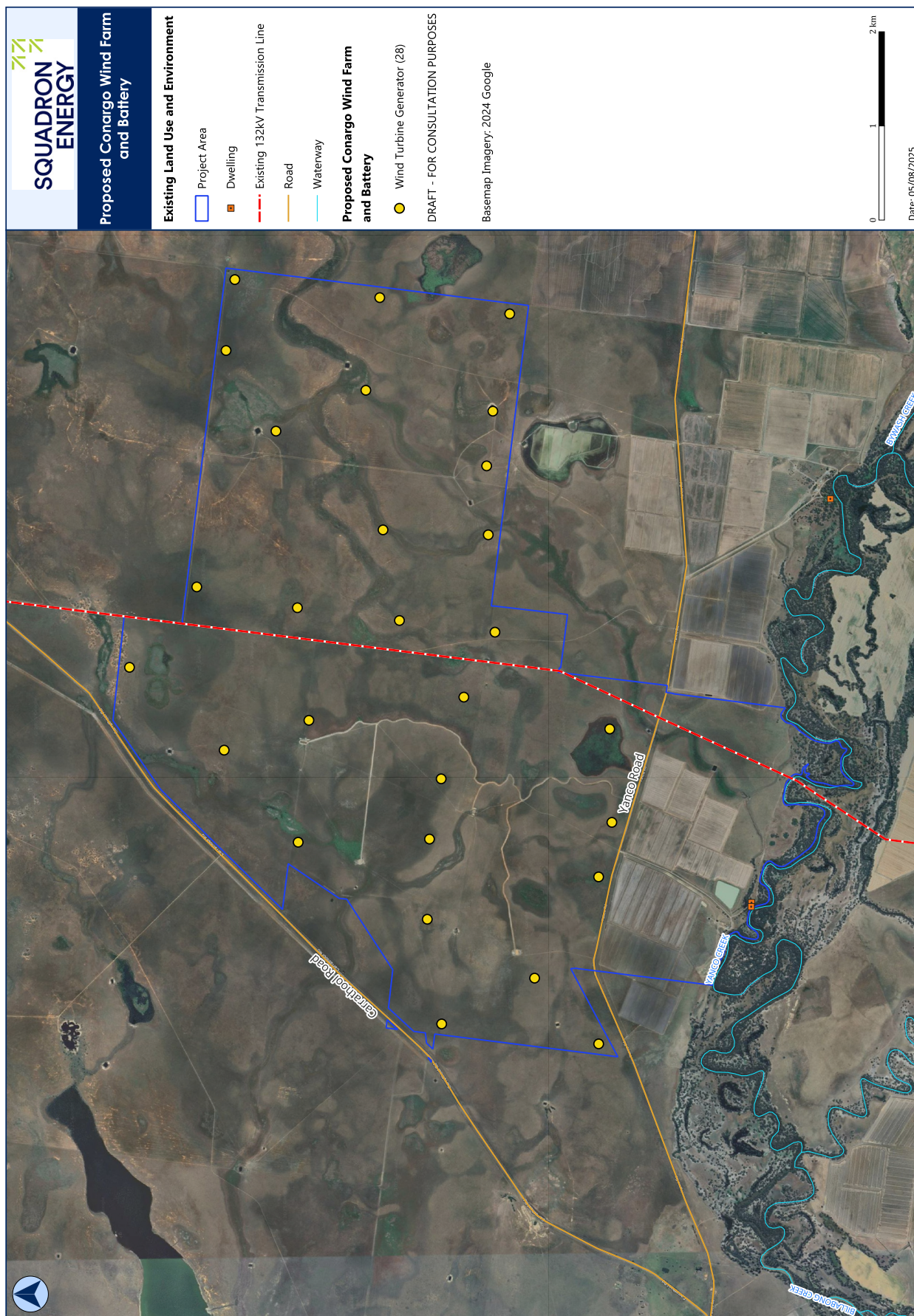
There is potential to connect to the existing transmission line on site, and the project size has been adjusted accordingly while we explore this option. We have revised the proposed number of turbines to 28, now spanning a larger investigation area, further from Yanco Creek following landowner and community consultation. The updated Conargo Wind Farm and Battery layout is on the next page.

This layout may continue to be refined as we progress through technical assessments and carry out further community and stakeholder engagement.

Next steps

Biodiversity studies are ongoing, and detailed environmental studies including visual impact assessment will start soon. We expect the Environment Impact Statement to be lodged in late 2026.

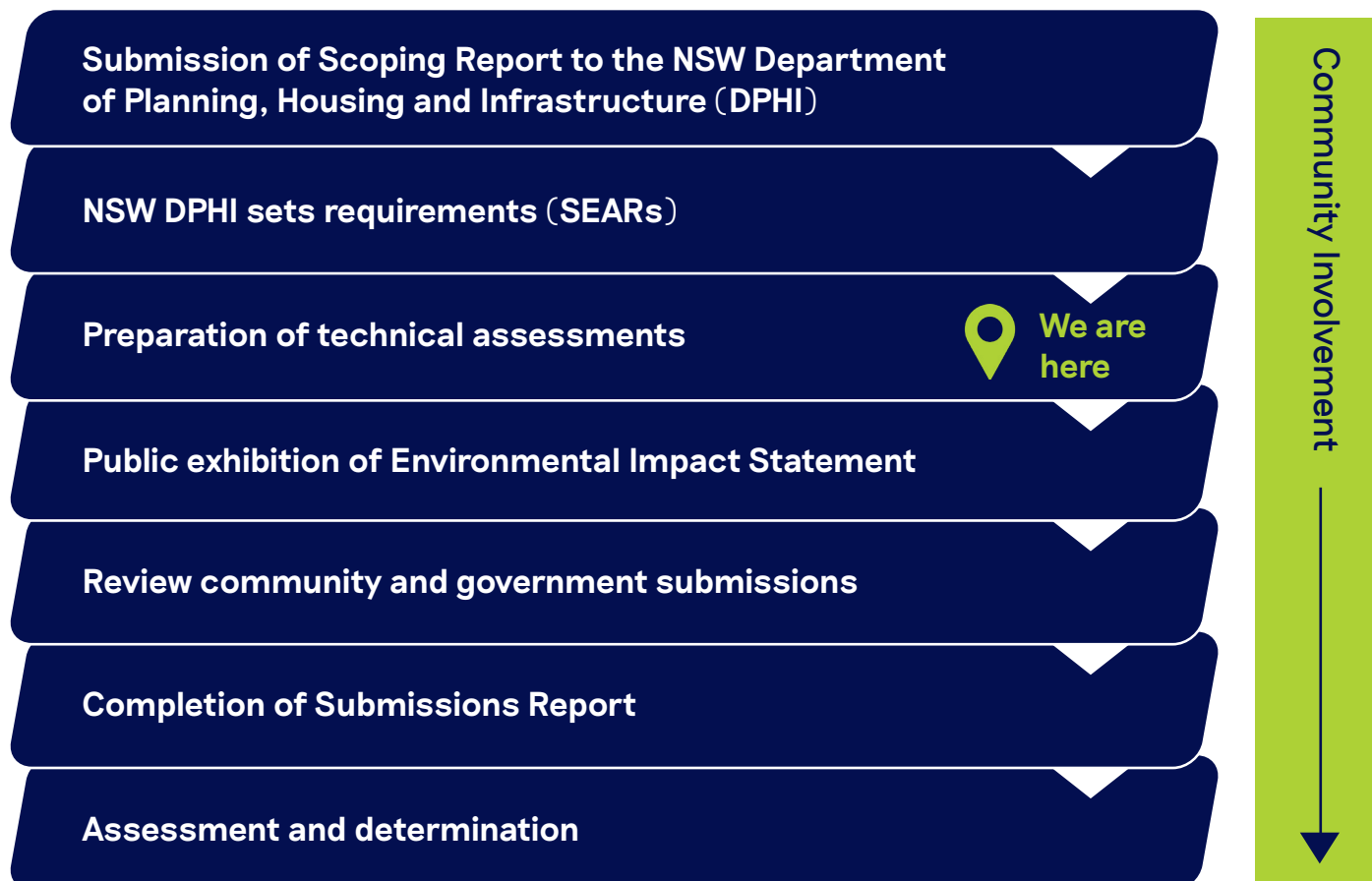
A wind monitoring device called a meteorological mast or 'met mast' is expected to be installed on the project site. This will be used to confirm wind speeds up to 160m above ground level.

In the coming months, we will continue to refine the project design based on insights gained from ongoing environmental assessments and community feedback. We will keep the community and our stakeholders updated as we progress with the development of the project.
