Project update

The Clarke Creek Wind Farm project team has successfully completed the installation of all 100 turbines, marking a major milestone for the project. Thank you to our project team and all our partners involved.

With more than \$500 million invested across the state, including \$110 million flowing directly into regional communities during construction, the project is delivering more than green energy.

Commissioning is completed with wind turbines ready to be online and generate clean energy since November 2025.

The Operations team has moved into the Operations and Maintenance building at Access 4, and the project site office at Access 1 is being demobilised.

Squadron Energy owner Dr Andrew Forrest AO and Squadron Energy CEO Rob Wheals, marked the 100 turbine milestone in October with a site visit.

Power Promise Program

Squadron Energy's Power Promise Program is a community investment initiative that provides direct energy-related subsidies to households in regional communities, ensuring a share in the benefits of Australia's clean energy transition.

The Clarke Creek Energy Bill Bonus pilot is part of the program and available to residents and businesses within 20km of Clarke Creek Wind Farm – Stage One. Eligible applicants receive a \$1,000 annual rebate on their electricity bills, delivered directly via our partner ReSwitch.
