

UWF internet rebate/ Reswitch Terms and Conditions

Eligibility and Participation

1. Participation in the Uungula Connect program (“**Program**”) is by invitation only and subject to meeting the eligibility criteria.
2. Only one account will be issued per eligible household or business address, regardless of the number of occupants, accounts or meters.
3. Eligibility is determined based on address verification and active internet account status at the verified address.
4. Eligibility is determined based on the property being located within approximately 10 kilometres of the Uungula Wind Farm boundary, as determined by Reswitch.

Nature of the Program

5. The Program is a community internet connectivity initiative funded by Squadron Energy as part of its commitments associated with the Uungula Wind Farm. The Program provides eligible participants with a financial rebate to offset the costs of establishing and maintaining internet connectivity at their property.
6. Each eligible participant is eligible for a total rebate package of up to \$3,200 (including GST) over a maximum period of 24 months, paid on a claims made basis upon submission of eligible expenditure.
7. Participants who register more than 12 months after the Program launch date will receive a pro-rata allocation based on the remaining Program period.
8. Rebates may be claimed for expenditure that is reasonably and directly associated with establishing or maintaining internet connectivity at the eligible property, including:
 - a. internet service subscriptions (e.g., Starlink, NBN, or other licensed broadband providers);
 - b. satellite or ISP hardware (e.g., Starlink dish and router kit, Starlink “mini” NBN modem/router);
 - c. professional installation, including mounting, cabling, and associated electrical work directly related to internet equipment;
 - d. mounting equipment (e.g., pole mounts, roof mounts, tripods, brackets, weatherproof enclosures); and
 - e. in-home and on-property network infrastructure that extends internet coverage, including mesh Wi-Fi systems, wireless access points, network switches, signal boosters, and internal cabling.

9. Rebates may not be claimed for:
 - a. Internet of Things (IoT) devices, such as smart sensors, water level monitors, soil moisture probes, livestock GPS trackers, remote cameras, and weather stations;
 - b. agricultural technology equipment, such as LoRaWAN gateways, farm telemetry kits, and precision agriculture hardware;
 - c. smart home devices, such as smart speakers, smart plugs, smart lights, and smart thermostats;
 - d. home security and CCTV systems;
 - e. mobile phone plans, portable hotspot devices, and mobile broadband dongles;
 - f. computers, tablets, and general IT equipment;
 - g. streaming, software, or gaming subscriptions;
 - h. television, radio, and telephone equipment; and
 - i. general electrical work not directly related to internet equipment installation. The Program is a funding rebate initiative only. It does not involve the provision of internet services or equipment or installation services by Squadron Energy or Reswitch.
10. You are solely responsible for engaging with internet service providers, suppliers or installers.
11. Nothing in the Program creates an agency, partnership, joint venture or employment relationship with Squadron Energy or Reswitch.
12. The Program is not a regulated financial product or service.

Participant Responsibilities

13. You are solely responsible for:
 - a. procuring any internet, equipment, services, or installations;
 - b. all costs associated with your chosen internet solution, equipment and installation, except to the extent reimbursed under the Program.
14. Squadron Energy and Reswitch have no responsibility for the performance, quality, suitability or availability of any internet service, equipment or installation works.

Rebate Conditions and Payment

15. Rebates are provided on a claims basis and are subject to verification by Reswitch.

16. To receive a rebate, you must provide evidence of eligible expenditure, which may include invoices, receipts, internet service contracts or account statements.
17. Equipment and installation cost claims must be linked to an active internet service at the eligible property at the time of the claim.
18. Squadron Energy or Reswitch may require periodic confirmation that the internet service remains active as a condition of ongoing claims.
19. Any unused portion of your rebate allocation will not be paid out in cash and will remain with Squadron Energy.
20. If your circumstances change and you no longer meet the eligibility criteria (e.g. relocation outside the eligible area), Squadron Energy reserves the right to remove you from the Program. You will be notified and advised of your options if this occurs.

No Warranties

21. Squadron Energy and Reswitch provide no representations, warranties or guarantees in relation to:
 - a. the availability, quality, speed or reliability of any internet service;
 - b. any equipment, installation or supplier; or
 - c. the suitability of any service or solution for a participant's needs.
22. You acknowledge that internet services are provided by third parties and may be subject to outages, delays or performance limitations beyond the control of Squadron Energy or Reswitch.

Limitation of Liability

23. Squadron Energy and Reswitch are not liable for any loss, damage, cost, tax, liability or expense arising out of or in connection with:
 - a. the procurement, installation or use of any equipment or services by participants;
 - b. any acts or omissions of third-party providers, installers or suppliers;
 - c. any defects, failures, delays or interruptions in internet services;
 - d. receipt of any rebate or payment; or
 - e. any inaccuracy or incompleteness in participant claims or supporting information.
24. To the extent liability cannot be excluded, it is limited to the amount of rebate paid to the participant under the Program.

Data Protection and Privacy

25. The personal information you provide to participate in the Program will be used by us in accordance with the Privacy Policy.
26. The Privacy Policy can be found on the Reswitch website.
27. By participating in the Program you:
 - a. acknowledge that you also agree to the terms of the Privacy Policy; and
 - b. you consent to being contacted by Squadron Energy and/or Reswitch from time to time for surveys, promotions, notifications and feedback.

Program Discretion

28. All payments and participation in the Program are entirely at the discretion of Squadron Energy and Reswitch.
29. The Program may be modified, suspended or terminated at any time.

Definitions

30. For the purpose of these terms and conditions:
 - a. Related Bodies Corporate means any related body corporate as defined in the Corporations Act 2001(Cth) and in the case of Squadron Energy means any related body corporate as defined in the Corporations Act 2001(Cth) but on the basis that 'subsidiary' has the meaning given to Subsidiary in this agreement and 'body corporate' includes any trust;
 - b. Reswitch means Reswitch Pty Ltd ACN 669509 139 and its Related Bodies Corporate.
 - c. Squadron Energy means UWF Nominees Pty Ltd ACN 660 499 221 and its Related Bodies Corporate.
 - d. Subsidiary means any subsidiary as defined in the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) but on the basis that:
 - i. a trust may be a Subsidiary, for the purposes of which a unit or other beneficial interest will be regarded as a share and the relevant 'board' for the purposes of section 46(a)(i) of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) will be the board of directors of the trustee of the trust; and
 - ii. a corporation or trust may be a Subsidiary of a trust if it would have been a Subsidiary if that trust were a corporation.
