Subject: Uungula Wind Farm – Traffic Management Plan for transformer and switch room delivery

Dear Mrs Somerville,

I refer to the Traffic Management Plan, updated to include the delivery of over-size over-mass (OSOM) transformers and switch room components, submitted for review and approval in accordance with Schedule 2, Condition B33 of the development consent for Uungula Wind Farm (SSD 6687). I also acknowledge your response to the Department's review comments and request for additional information.

I note the updated Traffic Management Plan has been prepared in consultation with Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and Dubbo Regional Council (DRC) and contains the information required by the conditions of consent to allow the delivery of over-size over-mass (OSOM) transformers and switch room components.

The Department has carefully reviewed the document and is satisfied that it meets the requirements of the relevant conditions in the consent.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the Traffic Management Plan (Revision 007C dated 15 May 2026), noting the proponent must continue to submit a letter report, via the Major Projects Portal every two months, detailing progress and any consultation updates.

The Department notes that this version (Revision 007C) of the Traffic Management Plan would still require updating to allow for high-risk OSOM wind turbine blade deliveries and to be submitted via the Major Projects Portal for Planning Secretary review and approval prior to commencing deliveries of wind turbine blades on the state road network. That future revision is to be prepared in consultation with TfNSW and DRC and capture the route analysis and required management measures for the OSOM wind turbine blade deliveries.
