Subject: Uungula Wind Farm – Traffic Management Plan

Dear Mrs Somerville,

I refer to the Traffic Management Plan, updated to include an increase in non-blade over-size over-mass (OSOM) movements prior to completion of the Mitchell Highway and Goolma Road intersection, and submitted in accordance with Schedule 2, Condition B33 of the development consent for the Uungula Wind Farm (SSD-6687).

Approval for continued use of the Mitchell Highway and Goolma Road intersection for non-blade movements prior to receiving Practical Completion from Transport for NSW (TfNSW) was given by the Planning Secretary under Schedule 2, Condition B30 (SSD-6687-PA-81).

I note this Traffic Management Plan:

- includes these changes, including consultation with TfNSW and Dubbo Regional Council (DRC); and
- contains the information required by the conditions of consent to allow the delivery of all OSOM components for the project, including blades.

The Department has carefully reviewed the document and is satisfied that it meets the requirements of the relevant conditions in the consent.

Accordingly, as nominee of the Planning Secretary, I approve the Traffic Management Plan (Revision 009 dated 30 July 2026), noting the proponent must continue to submit a letter report, via the Major Projects Portal every two months, detailing progress of OSOM movements and any consultation updates.

Please ensure you comply with the requirements of TfNSW as detailed in their letter dated 17 June 2026 and email dated 25 June 2026, and the commitments in the Traffic Management Plan, prior to the commencement of any blade movements.

You are reminded that if there are any inconsistencies between the Traffic Management Plan and the conditions of approval, the conditions prevail.

Please ensure you make the document publicly available on the project website at the earliest convenience.
