Environmental Permitting

- Commonwealth approval received under the Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act (EPBC Act) (dated 3/8/21) (http://epbcnotices.environment.gov.au/publicnoticesreferrals/)
- Management plans being drafted in consultation with various agencies and DPIE
- Secretary approval sought to use minor roads for pre-construction minor works linking back to Twelve Mile Road (western end)

Design

Road upgrade designs ongoing (liaison with Dubbo Regional Council and Transport for NSW)



- Tendering ongoing of the main contractor(s) to supply the wind turbines, civil and electrical construction (including road upgrades), and high voltage electrical connection to the grid
- Evening information seminar facilitated by the Orana Opportunity Network linking suppliers and head tenderers held on 19/8/21. Good attendance of approx. 75 suppliers.
